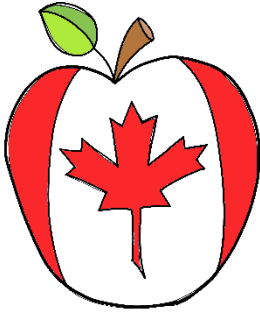
a federal political party based in Quebec to protect Quebec's interests

constituency

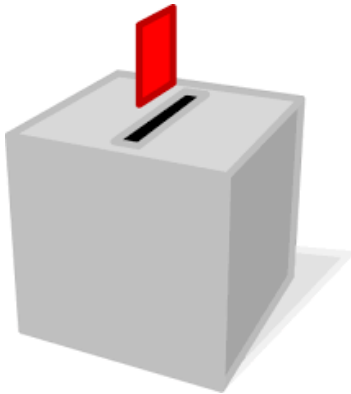
an area (also called a "riding") that a Member of Parliament represents in the House of Commons

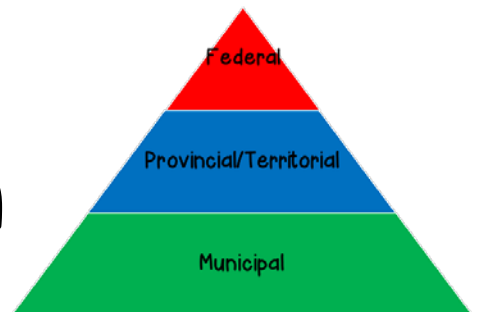

New Democratic Party of Canada (NDP)

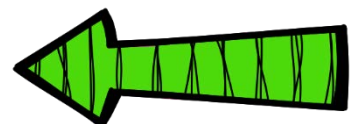

Parliament

the elected federal government consisting of the Governor General, House of Commons, and Senate
