

by Brod Bagert

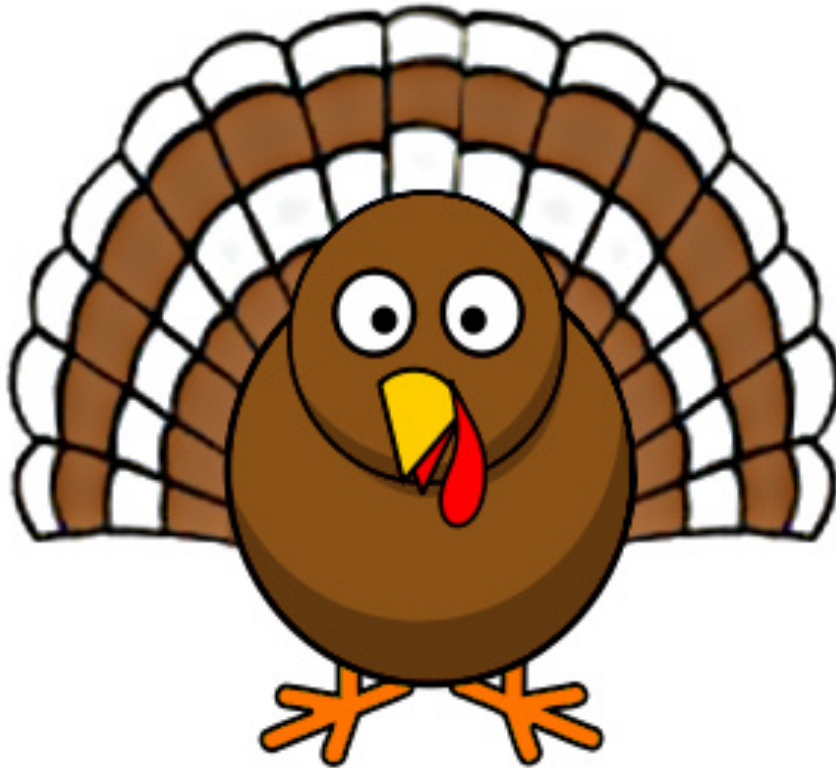
Sweet-potato-pie! Sweet-potato-pie!
